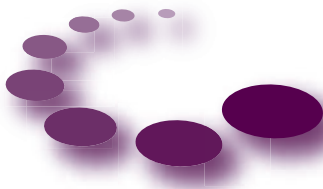

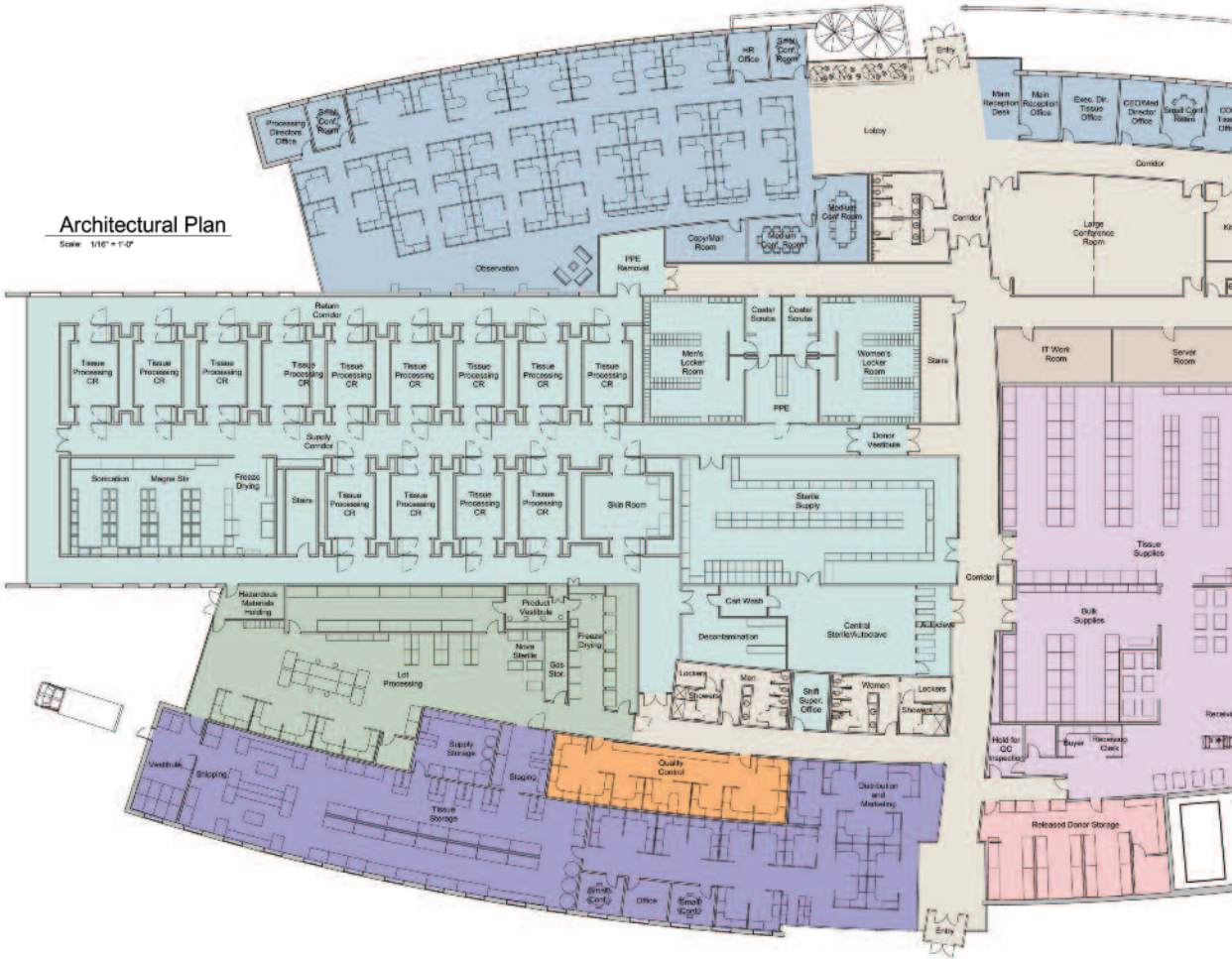

**Research Fund . . . . . \$2,000,000**

*A fund to bring leading-edge scientists and biotech experts to Community Tissue Services to aid the development of new tissue grafts and innovative products.*

**Research and Development Laboratory . . . . . \$500,000**

*Community Tissues Services' future in tissue banking, tissue engineering and regenerative medicine is pioneered through the R&D laboratory.*

**Entrance Circular Drive . . . . . \$250,000**

*This entrance is decorative and attractive to welcome all to the Center.*

**Lobby/Reception Area . . . . . \$250,000**

*A welcoming area of the Center for Tissue, Innovation and Research creates visitors' first impression of the Center.*

**Associate Lounge/Café . . . . . \$200,000**

*An area for relaxing, rejuvenating and sharing breakfast, lunch, dinner or a snack with co-workers, clinicians, other industry partners and visitors.*

**Clean Room Observation Wall . . \$150,000**

*A respectful area that highlights the cutting edge technology required to transform the gift of donated tissue into grafts needed by patients worldwide.*

**Reflection Pool/Pond . . . . . \$150,000**

*A restful area for reflecting and honoring donors and donor families.*

**Patio/Pavilion . . . . . \$150,000**

*An outdoor patio terrace and pavilion area that overlooks the landscaped grounds and pond.*

**Isolated Labs . . . . . 2 at \$100,000 each**

*These labs will support future innovations in biotechnology, tissue engineering and regenerative medicine.*

**Large Conference**

**Rooms . . . . . 2 at \$75,000 each**

*A comfortable meeting environment which provides state-of-the-art audio and visual capabilities where new ideas are explored and created, and where collaborative decisions are reached. These areas are also available for other organizations to host meetings.*

**Clean Rooms . . . . . 13 at \$50,000 each**

*The bulk of Community Tissue Services' manufacturing processes happen in state-of-the-art clean rooms that meet the highest industry standards and provide the ideal environment to create tissue grafts and products patients need.*

**Skin Clean Room . . . . . \$75,000**

*This is where life-saving skin is prepared for patients suffering from severe burns.*

**Directors' Offices . . . . . 3 at \$50,000 each**

**Distribution/Marketing Area . . . \$50,000**

*This dedicated area operates 24/7, and is where finished tissue grafts are requested and shipped across the U.S. and around the world.*

**Information Technology**

**Server Room . . . . . \$35,000**

*This dedicated room is the nerve center for Community Tissue Services, allowing communication among Community Tissue Services' locations, and with hospitals, medical professionals and partners across the U.S. and around the world.*

**Quality Control Area . . . . . \$35,000**

*This area is designated to ensure the utmost safety and quality of the life-saving and life enhancing grafts and products Community Tissue Services provides.*

**Kitchenette . . . . . \$35,000**

**Executive . . . . . \$30,000**

**Medium . . . . . 3 at \$25,000 each**

**Small . . . . . 4 at \$20,000 each**

**Inspection Room . . . . . \$25,000**

**(Men's and Women's) . . . . . \$25,000**

*These rooms provide a changing/storage area for the dedicated and highly trained technicians who transform tissue donor gifts into grafts and products which help to restore people's lives.*
